SUGGESTED POST-SCREENING DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How can bridge building, depolarization and cross-community organizing further progress on divisive issues?
- How have political divisions impacted issues like criminal justice reform and the addiction crisis in our community? What stands in the way of working across divisions?
- What are potential areas of common ground on these issues?
- How do we or can we work together with those we disagree with? What are some tools for listening, holding space for disagreement, and respecting others points of view?
- How can we (as educators, people of faith, students, mothers/fathers, business people) and engaged citizens advocate for social justice issues like criminal justice reform?
- How can we use deep listening and meaningful discourse to build bridges, improve collaboration and move closer to finding solutions?



TIPS FOR HOSTING A SCREENING

In Advance of The Screening

- Decide if your Screening will be Virtual or In-Person
 - Virtual Screening: Select a platform that works best for the people you anticipate attending. (<u>GoodDocs</u>, <u>Prime Video</u>, <u>VUDU</u>)
 - In Person Screening: Sign Up to Host an In-Person Screening
- Hold a prep call with THE FIRST STEP film team to confirm the date, time, and other key details
- Work with your organization to identify your target audience and how to best reach them
- Identify 2 panelists and a facilitator to conduct a post-screening discussion
- Create a run-of-show to help keep time throughout the event
- Prepare critical thinking questions / discussion points ahead of the event (See Suggested Post-Screening Discussion Questions)

Promote the Screening

- Invite organizational members or allied local partners to participate in post screening discussion or help promote the event
- Add the event link to your organization's events page and encourage advance registrations or ticket sales.
 - Share the film's trailer on social media
- Publish an email blast/newsletter to your community + supporters
- Tag the film at **@firststepmovie** for further engagement

Day of the Screening

- Publish one last social media push ahead of the screening
- Make sure to do a tech check before your event!
- Prepare opening remarks/introduction for the film screening
- Share your impact goals and calls-to-action with your audience
- Thank participating partners
- Take photos and share via social media (remember to tag us @firststepmovie)!

HOSTING AN AMAZON PRIME VIDEO WATCH PARTY

Create a Watch Party Link

- Locate THE FIRST STEP film on Amazon Prime Video.
- Select Watch Party 🎉 from the detail page.
- Enter a desired user name under Chat name.
- Click Create Watch Party to generate a Watch Party Link.
- Invite up to 100 participants using the "Share" Icon or Select "Copy Link" to share it via third party applications.






To End a Watch Party


- Under the Settings tab in the right-hand side pane, you will see an "End Watch Party" button under the Watch Party details section.
- Click the 'End Watch Party' button. Hit 'Yes' to confirm.






